Character Qualities:

Walk with God - Time each day in Prayer & reading the Bible; Vitality in your walk with God. Faith - Having faith to believe that God will work; that God's kingdom is breaking-out of the very air around us. (Hebrews 11:6) Spirit Filled Living (Galatians 5:16,22,23,25) Nay-sayers need not apply.

Grace & <u>Truth</u> – We should follow Jesus' example of being "full of grace & truth." (John 1:14) Servant Heart - Leadership should be first and foremost servant-hood, just as Jesus said, "the greatest among you shall be your Servant." (Matt. 23:11; Mark 9:35; 10:43; John 12:26) Moral Purity - Living in such a way that honors God, with actions that are above reproach.

This includes avoiding sexual immorality, being drunk, pornography or immodest dress. (Eph. 5:1,2,18; 1 Thess. 4:1-8; 1 Tim. 2:9,10; 3:1-3; 2 Tim. 2:22; Matt 5:28) (Leaders will disqualify themselves IF they choose these behaviors.) "Avoid every form (appearance) of evil" 1 Thes. 5:22

Commitment to the Team - Unity; Meeting Weekly; Teamwork; Servant-hood

You will need to be a team member, working with others to make the weekly meeting work well. Many hands make light work, when we work together. Developing new leaders is a high priority.
